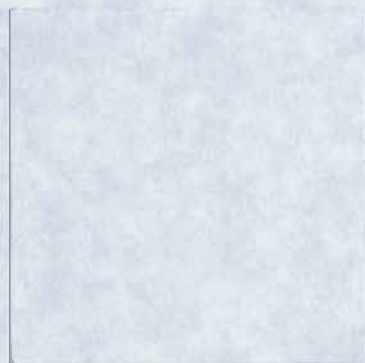

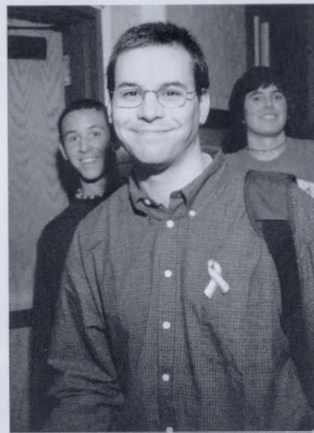
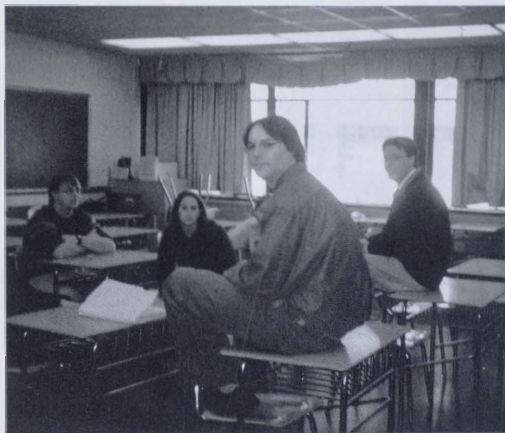

could come and talk to one of you about it. Looking back on our four years at Housatonic, we thank you for always believing in us and helping us to prepare for the rest of our lives.



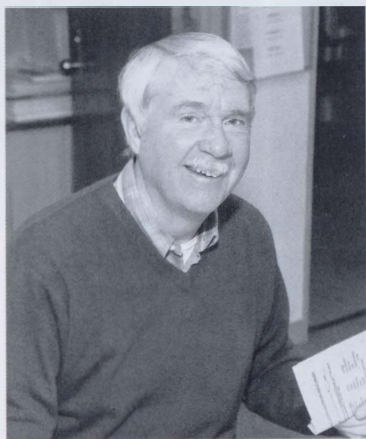
## Advisors Thank You

## Academic Bowl

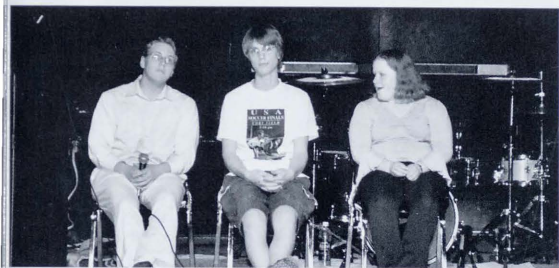
