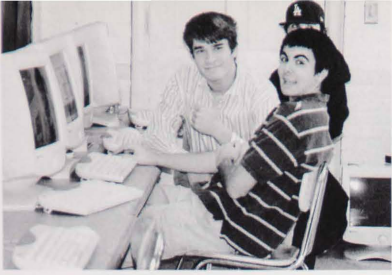




# Francofête 2006
