# Women's Cross Country

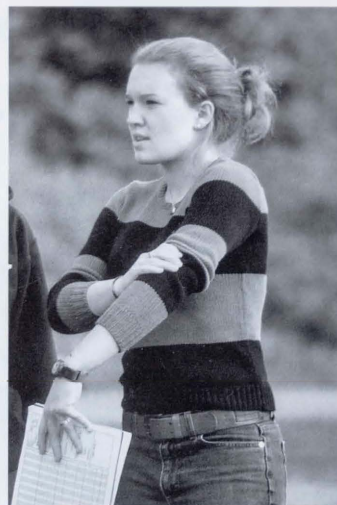
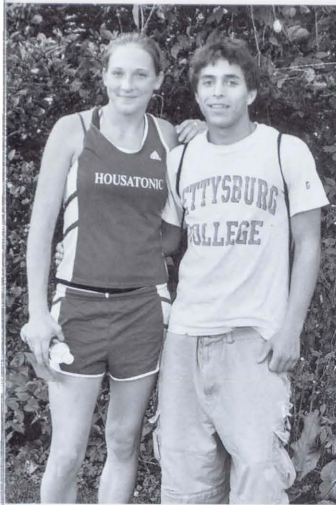

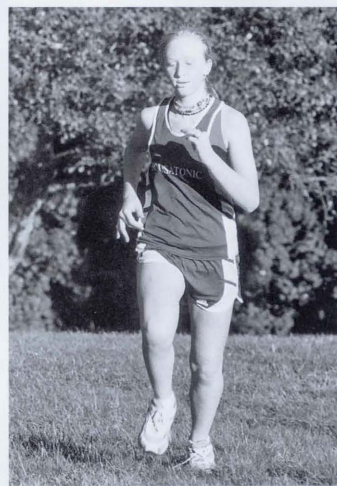

# Mens Cross Country

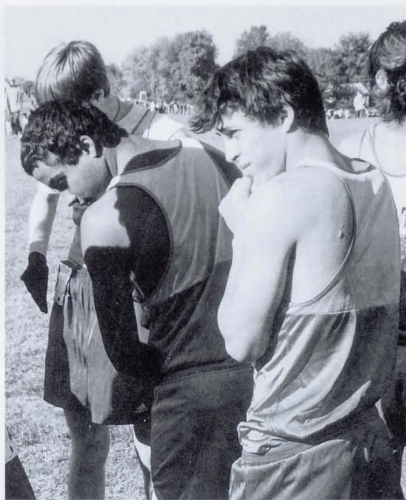

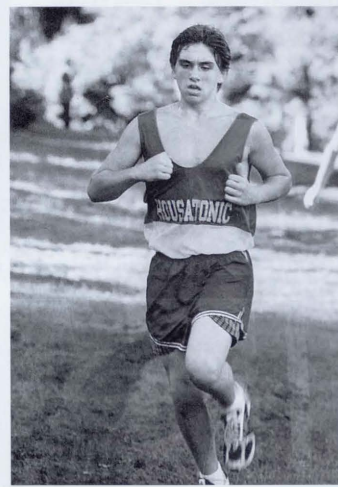
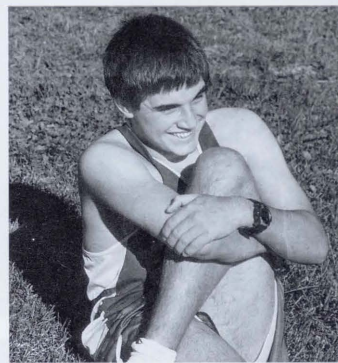

# Football

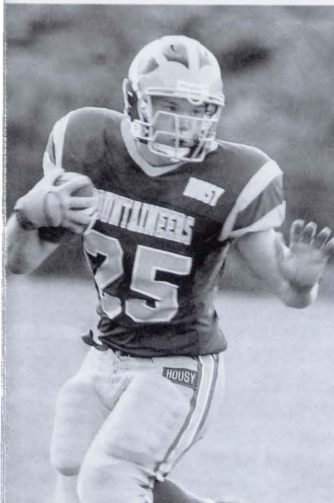

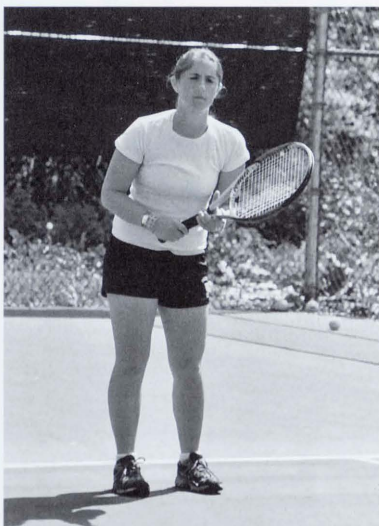
## Womens Tennis

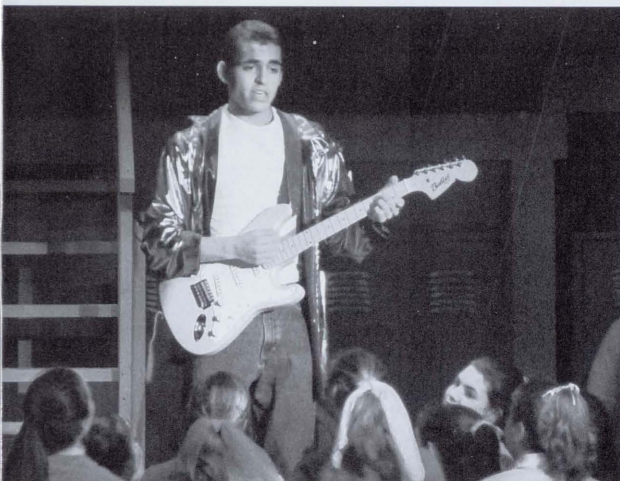




# Grease
