INDOOR TRACK



Most meets were large school, team scored events in which these Mountaineers did not fare well, but they did very well as individuals and carried the name of "Housatonic" through Connecticut. The girls gained medals and fame at Haddam-Killingworth in the unofficial "S tourney", and several boys did well in Class M. Greg Ferriss made it to the State Open, running his best time ever in the 1000, then became All-State two months later when he was moved up one position due to a disqualification of the runner above him in the rankings.
