## A final chat with Mr. Lindsay...

What will you miss most about Housatonic?

The kids. I love students of all ages, even the bad ones. We have a good group of kids here, even my original students were good and now they are some of your parents. We have a small enough school to get to know and enjoy the kids.

Has Housy changed a great deal since you first started?

Yes. Now we teach more things and we prepare students for the real world. Nowadays it is harder to be a student. Although students have become more rude as people, I think that more parents allow that kind of behavior. It is also harder to teach these days. You have to put on a show. It's not good unless you're a showoff like me.

How do you feel about retiring? What are your plans for the future?

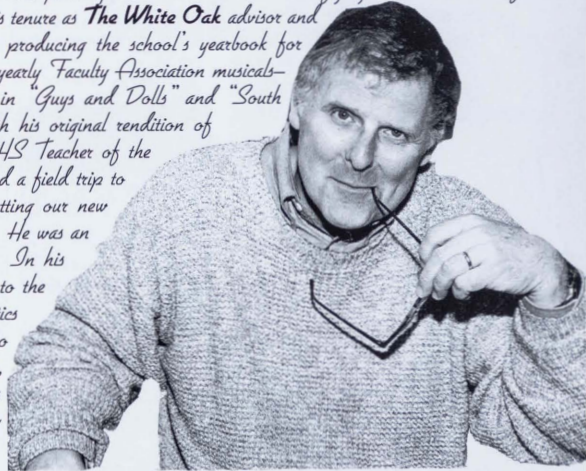
I am excited now. I wasn't excited when I first decided that this was the year—it was weird to think that I wouldn't have a homeroom in September. I will eventually move to Maine to live near my youngest daughter and her family. I plan to help the robotics team in January and the track team in April.

What does the future hold for Housatonic? Do you have any advice?

I can see cycles because I have been here so long, and I think students are getting more involved in school stuff. This is a great school and community. I think all new teachers should work first and then teach, so they can get a balance for how teaching fits in to the world, and share activities with students.

*The Class of 2007 and The White Oak staff would like to say goodbye and thank you to Mr. David Lindsay. Mr. Lindsay was a fixture at this school since 1966. Three years later he started a Geology course, team teaching with Principal Ed Kirby. That was the beginning of his many infamous*

*adventure tours that took both colleagues and students alike to exotic destinations. School would close in June and a bunch of science-oriented kids would find themselves riding in a van with their teacher to faraway places such as Mt. St. Helen's after it erupted in 1980 (he couldn't get near it, so he rented a plane and took pictures that were later used in class discussions), Death Valley, Sierra Mountains, Rocky Mountains, Joshua Tree National Park, and the dried creek bed of the Salton Sea. His international tours included two trips with the Spanish Club, where he was once pick-pocketed in Madrid. Since the average teaching salary in the 1960's was \$6,500, he supplemented his income by coaching and doing custodial work (mowing the back fields, pulling ivy down off the front walls, and painting the backstop on the baseball field) in order to support his young family. His extensive coaching career began in the early 1970's when, after installing boards obtained from the Salisbury School for a skating rink, he found a note in his mailbox appointing him Housy's first ice hockey coach (the boards leaked during the second season). In his 40 years as track coach, he led the Mountaineers to 11 Berkshire League championships and two state titles—once flying to Vermont with fellow teachers to cheer on one of our outstanding runners. In 1968, he began his tenure as **The White Oak** advisor and for the next 37 years spent countless nights, weekends, and summers producing the school's yearbook for generations of Housatonic grads. During the seventies he had roles in the yearly Faculty Association musicals—most notably as a singing waiter in "Cabaret" as well as appearances in "Guys and Dolls" and "South Pacific." He was also known to have entertained the student body with his original rendition of "Sixteen Candles." Among his many accolades, he was named HVRHS Teacher of the Year, created the Inventions and Patents course (which of course involved a field trip to the U.S. Patent Office in Washington, DC), was instrumental in getting our new track built, and also saved the old agriculture building from demolition. He was an innovative teacher always looking for new experiences for his students. In his very special devotion to kids and adventure, he was Housatonic's answer to the Pied Piper. That is especially true of his role in the FIRST Robotics program, winning many regional and state competitions in addition to earning recognition for creativity and design. He was the creator, leader, and guru. Students followed him to the point where they became leaders themselves. That is what education is meant to be. And he will be sorely missed.*

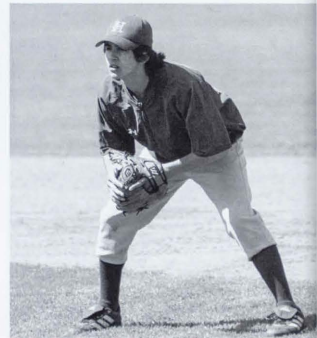


## Top 6...
