# What is Agricultural Education?

What is Agricultural Education?

Agricultural education teaches students about agriculture, food and natural resources. Through these subjects, agricultural educators teach students a wide variety of skills, including science, math, communications, leadership, management and technology.

Agricultural education is delivered through three interconnected components:

Classroom or laboratory instruction.

Experiential learning — Learning experiences that usually take place outside of the classroom, supervised by the agriculture instructor.

Leadership education — delivered through student organizations such as the National FFA Organization, the National Young Farmer Education Association, National Post secondary Agricultural Student Organization and others.

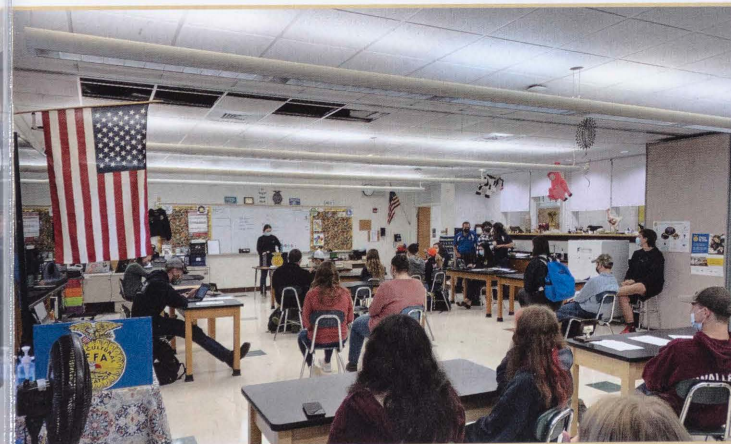

# Agricultural Education *Life Skills*

Welcome to the world of Agricultural Science and Technology. Housatonic Valley is one of twenty-one programs in the state. We are rich in tradition, community support, and leadership. Students in our program learn to recognize the importance of agriculture, food, fiber, and natural resource systems more fully. Through the completion of our courses, they evaluate how these systems impact their lives and the world and become well-informed consumers.

The courses in Agriculture Science and Technology Education are open to all HVRHS students. They are designed to provide education, career training, and experiences in the many areas of natural resources, agricultural engineering, biotechnology, animal science, and plant science. The Agriculture Science and Technology Center consists of classrooms, a fully equipped food science lab, an agricultural mechanics shop, an animal barn, a small animal room, an aquaculture / hydroponics lab, a greenhouse, and a forest woodlot laboratory. Students learn about the environment and the relationship among animals, plants, and machinery in our ever-changing productive society.

Students enrolled in Agriculture classes are invited to join the HVRHS FFA Chapter. The National FFA Organization is a dynamic youth organization that changes students lives through preparation for premier leadership, personal growth, and career success. FFA members are the enthusiastic leaders of tomorrow, promoting American values, citizenship, and civic participation. Students can participate in career development events, leadership development events, community service activities, leadership conferences, proficiency award recognition, and apply for scholarships through the National FFA organization. Additional opportunities include competing in the Envirothon, Electrathon, and participating in events at the local, state, and national levels. The personal growth, leadership, and career success skills that are developed through FFA serve a student well throughout life in a variety of vocational and avocational pathways.

Students enrolled in Agriculture classes have countless opportunities to apply what they learn in class to real life. One way that our students do this is through supervised Agricultural experiences (SAE). SAE projects are a catalyst for personal growth, career development, and responsible citizenship that leads to individual and societal benefits that complement a formal education. Skills, knowledge, and connections gained through SAEs remain with students for a lifetime and positively influence others along the way. An SAE is more than an integral part of agricultural education; it is tangible learning with an applied purpose and measurable results.







# FFA Floriculture

The Floriculture Career Development Event (CDE) requires students to identify plants, judge flower arrangements and solve problems. Participants also demonstrate skills in flower arranging, propagation and the preparation of floral and foliage products for sale.

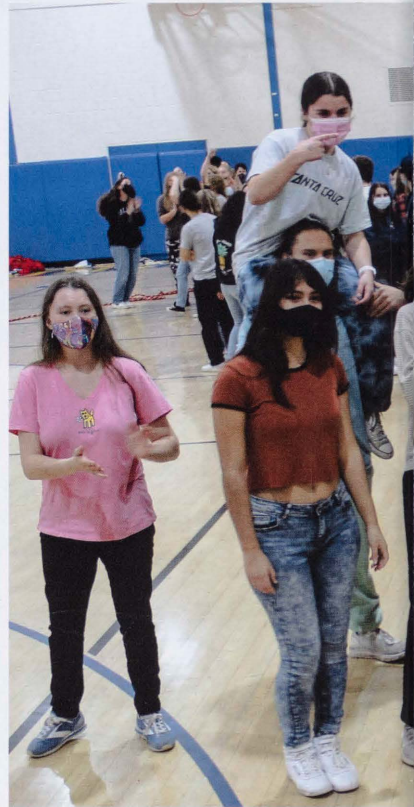

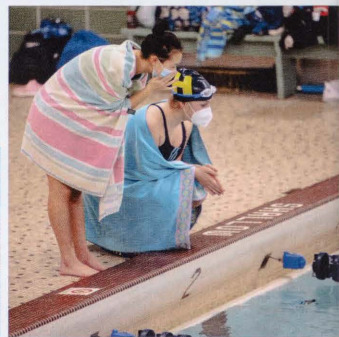
# Swimming

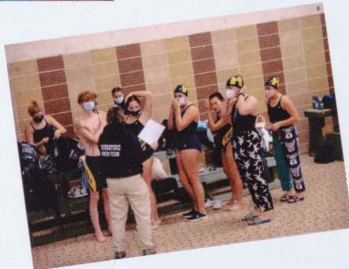

Segalla won the 100, 200 and 400 at the BL championships and repeated the feat at the Class S championships, where she established new meet records in the 100 (11.9) and 400 (52.96)

Segalla then won both the 200 and the 400 at the State Open before finishing first in the 400 and second in the 200 at the New England Interscholastic Championships.

She also took sixth in the 400 at the New Balance Nationals Outdoor, earning All-America status in the process.



Segalla was then named the Gatorade Connecticut Girls Track & Field Player of the Year.

Segalla admitted it felt "weird" to be recognized for track and field since soccer is her primary sport. I thought that I would do well in the Berkshire League," she said. "That was my intent, that was my goal. Never did I think I would be going to nationals and winning Gatorade player from my state.
