Stevenson — "We've done very well considering we're such a small team with such a limited practice facility."

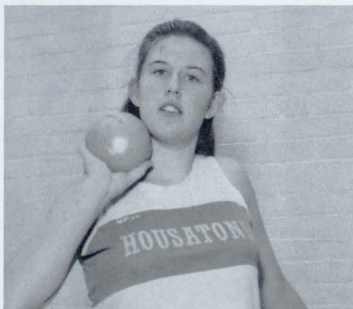
