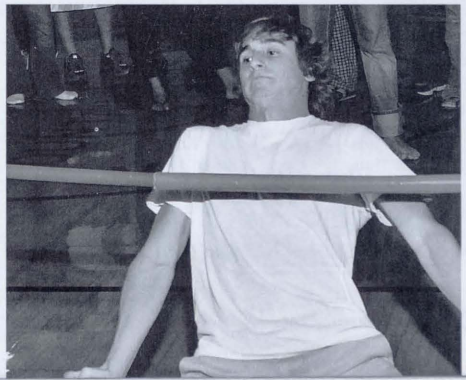
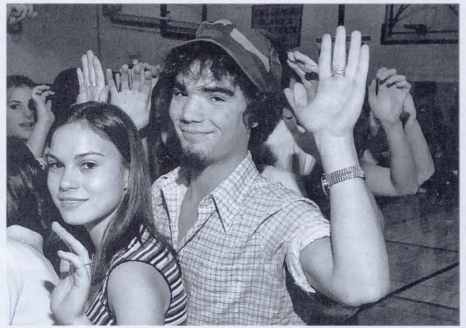
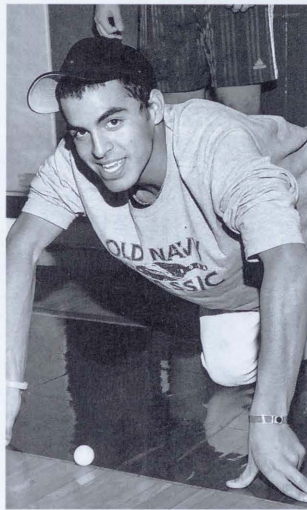
# Hoops For Heart
