FOOTBALL

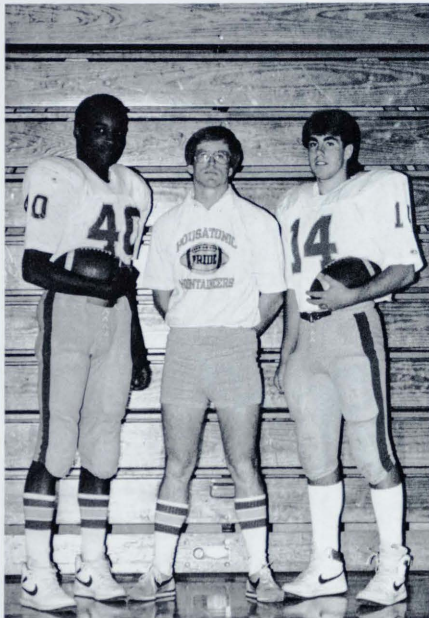

BOYS BASKETBALL

For the first time in five years Housatonic sent its boys' basketball team to the State Tournament. From the team's opening round win there was improvement noticed, and HVRHS went 11-10 after being winless the previous year.
