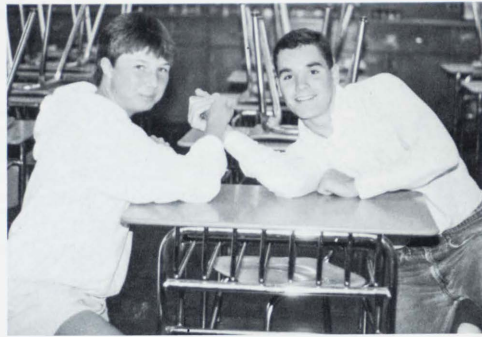
SCHOLAR ATHLETES
